Q&A session:

Now, why do I bring this up? It is not to defend Italian fascism. But it is to point out that Fascism, like Nationalism, is inherently going to bring up the internal characteristics of a people. And, uh, in Italy it brought out Italian characteristics; in Germany it brought out German characteristics. The German characteristics were a lot nastier. Um, and this is a big part of Daniel Jonah Goldhagen's argument about the, sort of, Hitler's willing executioners: there was an exterminationist [sic] sort of anti-Semitism in the genetic DN-, in the DNA of Germany that just didn't exist in Italy. There was anti-Semitism in Italy, but it was usually theological anti-Semitism. It was: 'you guys should be Christians'. It was not: 'you guys are biological vermin that need to be destroyed'.
